## Free Recycling Bin Drop-off:



### Combine - PLASTIC #1 & #2 Bottles / GLASS

/ ALUMINUM / TIN: Bottles, Cans, Aerosol, & Jar

Food Containers ONLY. (Labels/caps can be left on. Drain & dbl rinse motor oil, transmission fluid, herbicide & pesticide bottles.)

No: plastic bags, window glass, ceramics, china, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramic cookware, aluminum siding, or nonmetal cookware



### Paper - NEWSPAPER / MAGAZINES / JUNK

MAIL / OFFICE PAPER: Inserts, Catalogs, Glossy Flyers, Phone Books, paper (any color), & Envelopes (please put lrg amounts of office paper in plastic bag)

No: hard cover books, wrapping paper, food wrappers, tissue paper, paper towels, etc..



### Cardboard - BROWN CORRUGATED (flatten), CEREAL, CAKE, & CARDBOARD EGG CARTONS / PAPER BAGS:

No: waxed refrigerated boxes or cartons, detergent, produce, pizza, pop, beer, toothpaste, soap boxes etc..

### **Large & Commercial:**

- Call ahead for an apt. time
- Not accepted before 4:00 p.m.
- \$2.00 / Lb Fee
- Loads considered large:
  - \* over 500 lbs / 3 drums
  - \* full truck or trailer
- If arriving before 4:00 p.m. may have to wait on the side if line is long.



### **Latex Paint Fee:**

\$1/less than one Gal. Container  
\$2/one gallon container  
\$5/five gallon container

### **Dispose of Latex Paint:**

- \* Recycle empty paint containers.
- \* Put in trash as it is not hazardous.
- \* Pour into a plastic-lined cardboard box mixed with cat litter, sawdust, or paint drying solvent.
