 - 2. Flock cameras- \$3,000.00 per camera- would like 3 total cameras- Install \$950.00 for 3 cameras
 - I. <u>1 SQUAD RAIO</u>: Tabled by Police Protection Committee until Budget Preparation- purchase of 1 Squad Car Radio for an estimate of \$6,500.00, recommended by the Police Protection Committee.
 - II. **LAND DONATION BY DARRELL RUBEL:** Motion by Jensen/Mueller to deny the land donation of parcel # 146-00472-0000 to the Village from Darrell Rubel (owner of Sterling Bank) due to the additional expenses it would take to maintain the property, all in favor- aye, carried.
